CATERPILLARS ARE THE PRIMARY FOOD SOURCE FOR MANY BIRD SPECIES?

Both parents take turns feeding the chicks, enabling them to bring a caterpillar to the nest once every **3 minutes**. And they do this from 6 a.m. until 8 p.m. for each of the 16-18 days it takes the chicks to fledge.

That's a total of **350 - 570** caterpillars every day, depending on how many chicks they have.

So, an amazing **6,000 - 9,000** caterpillars are required to make one clutch of chickadees!
