## Join Us!


No experience needed!

We pot up seedling and learn various propagating techniques plants under the excellent direction of Robin Rietz, Propagation Director. On Wednesdays, we treat volunteers Peanut Butter & Jelly sandwiches but you can always bring your own snack! We work year-round in the warmth of a Greenhouse in cold months or in the shade of Sycamore-like trees in the heat!

Sometimes we tend our demonstration gardens. These are small sized landscapes that show others how to effectively use native plants in their own landscape.
